



## Global Health Fellowships for Doctors in Training in East of England

The East of England Global Health Fellowships (GHFs) provide opportunity to Doctors in Training in an East of England training programme and who are ST3 and above. They are a unique opportunity to develop greater understanding of global health and to participate in health partnership activities

This global health fellowship programme is provided by Cambridge Global Health Partnerships with funding and advice from NHS England East of England.

Global Health Fellowships are available to doctors in training in the East of England (ST3+).

Global Health Fellows can expect to:

- Have funded time equivalent to half a working day per week to dedicate to global health activities.
- Gain understanding of global health and skills in team working, leadership and management and governance, alongside their speciality knowledge and skills.
- Experience partnership working with healthcare professionals in the Global South within an existing health partnership supported by CGHP.
- Undertake a visit with their global health supervisor to international partners.
- Become a champion for global health within their training programme and across the East of England region.
- Join a support network for international staff working in the East of England with involvement in induction and mentorship.

## **Eligibility**

Open to trainees in East of England at ST3 or above. GHF posts are offered for 1 year subject to satisfactory progression and agreed educational objectives. The GHFs will be expected to work within an established health partnership working on existing projects. The specific work undertaken will depend on the interests of the GHF and agreement of NHS EoE supervisor – this may involve teaching, audit, guideline development and research.

- 2. You will also need to include written confirmation of support from your Training Programme Director.

- Interviews will take place on MS Teams on January 26, 2026.
- One-year fellowships will start at a date to be agreed with each GHF between mid-March to end April 2026.
